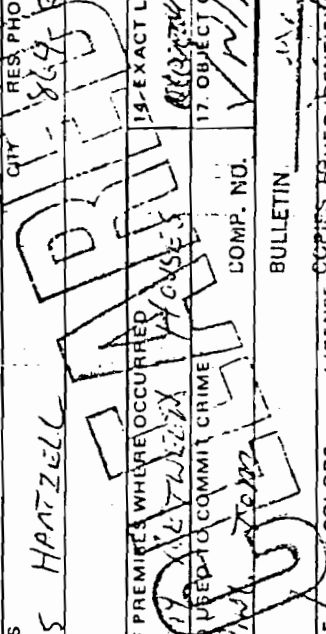

In furtherance R/O spoke with Laura Wilkinson, 17 and from her learned in summary that on 10/23/80, at about 11:10PM she went to her bedroom. The bedroom light was already on. The first and only floor is located 1/2 story above the ground. The lower cell of the bedroom window is only about two feet from the floor. When the c/w entered her bedroom she thought that she heard something outside her window, but, at first paid no attention. Seconds later she heard a sound that she had heard before. This was the sound of the offender walking with what sounded like hard shoes. The c/w turned off the bedroom light and saw the offender for the first time. The c/w feels that this was the same offender that she could only hear on a previous peeping tom offense. On this above occasion the c/w observed the subject standing outside on the side walk between 3035-3037 Hartzell, to the West of 3035 Hartzell. The subject then casually walked to the front of the house and across the street where he stood under the light for a few seconds, then walked on down the street and out of sight. In the mean time the police had been called, but, found no one in their area search.

DESCRIPTION:

W/M, late 20's to early 30's, 5-8 to 6-0, thin to mdm, dark, curly hair, dark or tinted glasses, mustache, beard(thick), Jean jacket, shoes that sounded hard heeled.

No other information could be obtained to further this investigation. R/O suggested that the c/w and her mother view photos, but, due to their separate schedules they could not comply at this time. The c/w mother, Karen Cooper, 40, s/a was home at the time and viewed the subject, also.
