VICTIM AT THAT POINT SAW TAIL LIGHTS OF A VEHICLE LEAVE S/B ON CENTRAL PK BUT COULD NOT DESCRIBE IT. OBSERVED ON THE GROUND AROUND PERIMETER OF THE HOUSE AT EACH GROUND LEVEL WINDOW WAS APX SIZE 10-11 SHOE PRINT. SHOE PRINTS WERE FACING IN TOWARDS LIVING AREA BUT NO EVIDENCE OF FORCE SEEN ON WINDOWS.
