In furtherance of investigation R/O spoke to Mr. Richard J. Woldow on Thursday, 18 Dec. 80 and learned in summary the following: Prior to questioning Mr. Woldow on 12/18/80 R/O advised Mallick of his rights per "Miranda" whereby he told R/O that he understood his "Miranda" rights and that he did wish to speak to R/O. R/O advised Mr. Woldow that on 12/08/80 a witness observed a subject driving a mustang parked said vehicle directly across from 2737 Highland Evanston and subject said vehicle walking then directly up to the private residence of Mrs. Joan Mallick. The subject who exited the mustang vehicle then looked directly into the victim's (Rev. Joan Mallick) window. When the witness, Gary Bryson, 3205 Otto Lane, realized that the suspicious subject was looking into his neighbors window he walked up to the suspect vehicle, Ford Mustang, and Woldow down the lic. plate number (HV9383 Ill. 80). Said registration checked to Mr. Richard J. Woldow, 33038 Hartzell, Evanston.

R/O interview Mr. Richard J. Woldow on the above noted date and time and at first he denied looking into the victims window saying that he was at home during the time of the above mentioned incident. At approximately 15 minutes after R/O's initial interview with Mr. Woldow he returned to the Det. Bureau and requested to speak with R/O. R/O again advised Mr. Woldow of his rights per "Miranda" whereby he told R/O that he was in fact on the premises of Mrs. Mallick and looked into her window. On Friday, 19 Dec. 80 Mrs. Joan Mallick came into the Evanston Police Dept., Det. Bureau and signed a complaint against Mr. Woldow. A subsequent arrest warrant was issued by Judge Mix on 19 Dec. 80 Richard J. Woldow was informed of said warrant by R/O and he advised that he would surrender himself on Tuesday, 23 Dec. 80
